EXAMINATION CONDITIONS

Students are to assemble outside their exam room 10 minutes before the exam is scheduled to commence.

Students may only take pencils/pens, correct calculators and other articles, designated for the exam, into the exam room. (refer to your subject teacher) Paper will be provided for scrap notes / working out.

No mobile phones are allowed into the exam room.



Please Note

Students are expected to be in full school uniform for all exams.

All exams commence with reading time of 10 minutes. No highlighting, underlining, writing or use of calculators is permitted during this period.

Students must take great care in reading the exam timetable. No extra time is allowed for students who come late to an exam.

Any **student who requires special conditions** for the examinations must contact Ms Sorrell ASAP so that the special arrangements can be made.

Talking and passing of information is not allowed in examinations and students requiring help from a supervisor should raise their arm to attract attention.

Students must remain in the exam room for the entire length of the exam period. Students may only leave the exam room in exceptional circumstances and under the supervision of a supervisor.

Students must observe instructions given by supervising teachers as well as those on the exam cover page.

At the conclusion of the exam period students must stop writing when asked by the supervising teacher. **Students are not to leave their desks until papers have been collected** and only after directed, by the supervisor, may they leave the room.
